One plan. One routine. Clear communication for everyone helping your puppy.

HOUSE RULES

- ☐ Use the same potty cue.
- ☐ Potty trips stay focused and on leash.
- ☐ Reward after the dog completely finishes.
- ☐ Bell / door signal means potty - not playtime.
- ☐ No punishment for accidents.
- ☐ If caught starting: calmly interrupt and go outside.
- ☐ If found later: clean thoroughly and adjust the plan.
- ☐ Freedom increases only after reliable dry time and communication.

Keep this sheet somewhere everyone can see it. Update it whenever the routine changes.

Daily Potty Log

Track each potty opportunity so you can see your puppy's real pattern instead of guessing.

HOW TO USE IT

Write the time for every potty trip. Check PEE, POOP, or NOTHING. If your dog does both, check both.

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WHAT PATTERN DO YOU NOTICE TODAY?

A pattern over several days is more useful than one unusually good or bad day.
